BUCKNELL IN NCAA TOURNAMENT FOR FIRST TIME SINCE 2002

BISON ENTER SECOND NCAA TOURNAMENT WITH SIX WINS IN LAST SEVEN GAMES

After being picked first in the Patriot League Preseason Poll, Bucknell was relegated to the underdog roll in the Patriot League Tournament and it responded. The Bison swept through the tournament as the fifth seed, defeating three higher seeded teams, including two on their home courts, to win their second Patriot League title and a berth into their first NCAA Tournament since 2002.

No. 16 seed Bucknell (16-15) will once again be in an underdog role as it faces top-seeded North Carolina (30-2) Sunday in Norfolk, Va.

The Bison, who have five experienced seniors on their roster, started out the season with a 5-9 non-league record. However, Bucknell played one of the most difficult schedules in program history and that difficult grind prepared it for conference play.

Unfortunately, sharp-shooting junior guard Amanda Brown missed seven Patriot League games with an injury, causing the Bison offense to never get into a rhythm and Bucknell lost six conference games by a total of 31 points. Its largest margin of defeat over that span was just seven points.

With Brown back in the lineup on a full-time basis, Bucknell claimed six of its final seven games entering the NCAA Tournament and is in the middle of its best streak since last year when it captured 20 wins for the third time in program history.

The strength of the Bison is their defense. Anchored by senior Hope Foster, one of the best shot blockers in NCAA history and a former Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year, and another former Defensive Player of the Year Kesha Champion, one of the best on-ball defenders in the conference, Bucknell is yielding just 58.5 points per game this season. Three of the top four scoring defense marks in program history have come over the last three years. The last time opponents averaged more than 60 points per game against Bucknell was 2004-05, Foster and Champion's freshman campaign.

On the offensive end, the Bison have four proven scorers in Foster, Champion, Brown and junior Lauren Schober. Foster and Champion have already accumulated more than 1,000 career points, something just 17 players in program history have done. Brown is less than 75 points away from joining that exclusive club, while Schober is sure to cross the threshold next year as well. Foster (11.4), Brown (11.2) and Champion (10.5) are scoring at better than 10 points per game this season, while Schober is netting 9.1 per contest.

While rebounding was often an achilles heel for Bucknell during the non-league portion of the schedule, it was much improved during the Patriot League slate. The Bison were outbounded by nearly 100 rebounds in non-conference play, but turned that around to hold a +10 advantage on the boards against league foes.

- Bucknell was picked first in the Patriot League Preseason Poll. It is the first time in program history the Bison were chosen first.
- Senior co-captain Hope Foster earned her third consecutive First Team All-Patriot League honor. She is the second Bison to land on the first team three straight years, joining Molly Creamer.
- Bucknell was the first No. 5 seed to win the Patriot League Tournament.
- Kesha Champion was named the Patriot League Tournament MVP, while Amanda Brown and Lauren Schober were named to the All-Tournament Team.
- Bucknell has made one other NCAA Tournament appearance (2002).
- Kesha Champion netted her 1,000th career point vs. Holy Cross in the Patriot League championship game. She is the 17th player in Bison history to reach that plateau.
- A Patriot League team has not won an NCAA game since Holy Cross in 1991.
- Bucknell's current four-game winning streak is its longest of the season.
- Hope Foster ranks 19th on NCAA career blocks list (343).

BUCKNELL FACTS

- Bucknell has won the Patriot League Presidents' Cup, the league's all-sports trophy, 13 times in the 17-year history of the Patriot League. The Bison have won the women's-only crown 13 times, including each of the last 10, and the men's six times.
- With three more Patriot League championships so far this year, Bucknell has now earned 68 crowns in 18 years in the league. In addition, Bucknell has had 86 conference players of the year, 77 PL coaches of the year and a whopping 457 individual league champions from sports such as cross country, track & field, swimming & diving, tennis and golf.
- Bucknell has already had five Academic All-District selections this year to boost its total to 245. Last year Bucknell had a school-record 20 all-district selections and three went on to earn national Academic All-America honors.
- Bucknell ranks fifth in the nation (to Nebraska, Notre Dame, Penn State and Stanford) in total number of ESPN The Magazine Academic All-America selections with 114 since 1970.
- Bucknell has claimed 110 Patriot League Scholar-Athletes of the Year since the league's inception as an all-sports conference in 1990-91. That is more than twice the next-highest total.
- Bucknell's men's basketball program knocked off Kansas (2005) and Arkansas (2006) in the first round of recent NCAA Tournaments.

BUCKNELL-NORTH CAROLINA SERIES

Bucknell and North Carolina have never met in women's basketball. The Tar Heels are the fourth first-time opponent for the Bison this year, joining Duke, Illinois-Chicago and James Madison. Bucknell is 0-3 in those contests.

BUCKNELL vs. ACC

North Carolina is the second ACC foe Bucknell has faced this season. The Bison lost 92-49 to Duke, a No. 3 seed in the Oklahoma City Regional, in December. Bucknell is 0-6 all-time against teams that are currently in the ACC, having also played Maryland, Mi-

ami and Virginia once each and Wake Forest twice. Prior to this year, the last time the Bison faced a current ACC school was in 1992 against Miami, which was not a member of the ACC at the time.

Hope Foster was named the Patriot League Preseason Player of the Year ... Amanda Brown and Hope Foster were selected to the Pre-season All-Patriot League Team ... Bucknell won 20 games for the third time in program history last year ... Bucknell has four of the top 25 scorers in program history on this year's team ... the Bison were ranked among the national leaders in scoring defense, field goal percentage defense and fouls per game in 2006-07 ... Bucknell has four players who are in their third years of being regular starters ... Bucknell has won at least 10 games 14 consecutive years ... Bucknell has finished with a .500 record or better in Patriot League play 13 of the last 14 years ... Hope Foster is the second Bison, and the sixth player in Patriot League history, to be named First Team All-Patriot League three years in a row ... Bucknell has advanced to the semifinals of the Patriot League Tournament five times in the last seven years ... Bucknell made its third appearance in the Patriot League championship game earlier this month.

HISTORY OF THE 16 SEED

The NCAA Tournament field expanded to 64 teams in 1994 and since then No. 16 seeds are 1-55 in the first round, with Harvard pulling off an improbable 71-67 victory at Stanford in 1998. Overall, No. 16 seeds are 1-56 as the Crimson lost in the second round to eventual Final Four participant Arkansas. The four No. 16 seeds last year lost by an average of 48 points to No. 1 seeds Connecticut, Duke, North Carolina and Tennessee.

BUCKNELL VS. NCAA FIELD

Bucknell is 0-3 this year against fellow NCAA Tournament teams. The Bison lost to No. 16 seed Cornell (74-63), No. 7 seed Marist (68-56) and No. 3 seed Duke (92-49). All three of those contests were on the road.

THE PATRIOT LEAGUE IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

The Patriot League has won one game in NCAA Tournament play. That victory was by Holy Cross in 1991, the first year of the Patriot League. Since that time Patriot League squads have lost 15 straight NCAA Tournament games by an average of nearly 35 points per contest. Bucknell's 80-56 loss to Baylor in the 2002 tournament was the second-lowest margin of defeat for a Patriot League team.

BUCKNELL'S ROAD TO THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

Bucknell won the Patriot League Tournament to earn the league's automatic berth into the NCAA Tournament. Here is a brief recap of Bucknell's Patriot League Tournament run:

- Bucknell 50, Army 47 (OT) (PL Quarterfinals) - Amanda Brown makes game-winning 3-pointer with 0.7 seconds left in overtime ... Brown leads Bison with 19 points ... Bison limit Black Knights to 17 percent shooting in second half.
- Bucknell 60, American 52 (PL Semifinals) - Joyce Novacek records second career double-double with 18 points and 13 rebounds ... Novacek scored 13 of Bucknell's first 18 points in second half ... Bison become first No. 5 seed to advance to Patriot League championship game ... Bucknell snaps top-seeded American's 11-game winning streak.
- Bucknell 57, Holy Cross 45 (PL Championship) - Patriot League Tournament MVP Kesha Champion tallied 13 points and eight rebounds, including the 1,000th point of her career ... freshman Cosima Higham gave a big lift off the bench with a career-high 10 points and six rebounds ... Bison end first half on 17-2 run ... Bucknell wins second PL title (and first since 2002).

TIES TO 2002

Two members of this year's Bucknell coaching staff were also involved with the Bison program in 2002, the only other time the team was in the NCAA Tournament. Head coach Kathy Fedorjaka was in her fifth year at the helm of the squad, while current assistant coach Monique LeBlanc was a senior on that 2001-02 team that won the first Patriot League title in school history.

BUCKNELL PATRIOT LEAGUE TOURNAMENT HISTORY

Bucknell has an all-time record of 13-16 in the Patriot League Tournament. The Bison have reached the championship game three times and advanced to at least the semifinals in five of the last seven years. Bucknell is 11-9 in Patriot League Tournament play under 11th-year mentor Kathy Fedorjaka.

No. 5 SEED HISTORY

This year was the fourth time Bucknell has been seeded fifth in the Patriot League Tournament. Each of the previous three times it was the fifth seed it won its first-round game to advance to the semifinals before losing there. Overall, No. 5 seeds are 13-5 in the first round of the Patriot League Tournament. Bucknell was the third No. 5 seed to advance to the Patriot League title game. Colgate (1996) and Lafayette (1997) are the other two No. 5 seeds to appear in the finals and both lost.

BUCKNELL SUCCESS IN NCAA TOURNAMENT

While Bucknell's women's basketball team has made just one other appearance in the NCAA Tournament, the Bison men's program made national headlines in recent years with a pair of NCAA Tournament victories. Bucknell, seeded 14th, upset Kansas in the first round of the 2005 NCAA Tournament. The Bison followed with a first-round victory over Arkansas in 2006 as a nine seed.

ANOTHER BUCKNELL-HOLY CROSS CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

When looking at both the men's and women's basketball Patriot League championship games since 2000, there have only been three years where the two schools have not met in a

BUCKNELL FAMILIAR WITH TED CONSTANT CONVOCATION CENTER

While many members of the Bucknell women's basketball team have never set foot inside the Ted Constant Convocation Center, many Bison administrators were in Norfolk just last month. Bucknell's men's basketball team played at Old Dominion as part of the ESPNU BracketBusters.

HOME COMING FOR CHAMPION

Bucknell senior guard Kesha Champion will get a chance to play in front of a hometown crowd in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. The Chesapeake, Va., native lives less than seven miles from the Ted Constant Convocation Center.

FIRST-ROUND LOSS TO TITLE THE NEXT YEAR

Bucknell became the fourth team in the last five years to go from losing in the first round of the Patriot League Tournament one year to a title the next. The Bison lost in the first round to Colgate last season and came back to win the title this year. Colgate (2004), Holy Cross (2005) and Army (2006) also won their championships one year after suffering a first-round loss.

HOLDING OPPONENTS UNDER 70

Bucknell has held 48 of its last 49 Patriot League opponents to less than 70 points. The only opponent during that span to net 70 against the tough Bison defense was Holy Cross in its 73-67 victory last month at the Hart Center.

200 REBOUNDS AGAIN

Hope Foster has corralled a team-high 222 rebounds this season. She is the first Bison player to record three consecutive 200-rebound campaigns since Vicki Quimby did it four straight years (1999-2002).

ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

Bucknell was well represented on the Patriot League All-Tournament Team. Senior co-captain Kesha Champion was named the tournament MVP, while juniors Amanda Brown and Lauren Schober earned All-Tournament Team honors. Champion averaged a team-best 12.3 points and pulled down 6.3 rebounds per game during the tournament. Brown, who made a buzzer-beating, game-winning 3-pointer in the quarterfinals against Army,

averaged 11.0 points per game, while Schober averaged 8.0 points per contest, but tallied double figures in both the semifinals and championship contest.

PATRIOT LEAGUE TOURNAMENT DEFENSE

Bucknell held all three of its opponents in the Patriot League Tournament under 30.0 percent from the field. Army (16-62), American (17-70) and Holy Cross (17-59) shot a combined 50-for-191 (26.2 percent) from the field. The Bison had never before held three consecutive opponents under 30 percent from the field. The 144 points Bucknell yielded in the three games was the best in Patriot League Tournament history for a team that played three games.

SECOND CONSECUTIVE POSTSEASON TOURNAMENT

After advancing to one national postseason tournament in its first 33 seasons, Bucknell is now in its second straight year participating in a national tournament. The Bison earned an automatic berth to the WNIT last year, falling at Hartford by a 70-54 score in the first round.

ANOTHER 1,000-POINT SCORER

With 13 points in the Patriot League championship game at Holy Cross, senior co-captain Kesha Champion became the second Bison player this year to record her 1,000th career point, joining classmate Hope Foster in the exclusive club that has just 17 members. Champion currently has 1,008 points to rank 17th in program history. Foster, who tallied the 1,000th point of her career in December against Penn State, stands ninth in program annals with 1,253 points. The last pair of Bison teammates to reach 1,000 career points in the same season was Desire Almind and Kate Franks in 2002-03.

32-GAME SEASON

The first round of the NCAA Tournament will mark the 32nd game of the season for Bucknell, the most in program history. The 2001-02 and 2006-07 squads played 31-game seasons.

WINNING STREAK EXTENDS TO FOUR GAMES

With its victory in the Patriot League championship game, Bucknell extended its winning streak to four games for the first time this season. Entering the final game of the regular season, the Bison had won two games in a row three separate times, but had been unable to extend that to three in a row.

ALL-LEAGUE SELECTION

Senior co-captain Hope Foster earned her third consecutive First Team All-Patriot League citation at the conclusion of the regular season. She is the second Bucknell player to land on the first team three straight years, joining Molly Creamer. It has been accomplished just six times in Patriot League history. In addition to her three First Team All-Patriot League honors, Foster has been the Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year (2006), Player of the Year (2007), Preseason Player of the Year (2008) and was named to the All-Rookie Team in 2005.

SENIOR CLASS

Over the course of the last four years, the Class of 2008 has put together a 64-55 record and ranks fourth in program history in victories.

With 18 minutes in the first round of the NCAA Tournament, Champion will tie Molly Creamer for the top spot on Bucknell's minutes played list.

OPENING MONTH 4-0

Bucknell has opened March with an unblemished 4-0 record. February of 2007 was the last time the Bison started a month with at least three consecutive victories. Bucknell has never before won four games in the month of March.

PATRIOT LEAGUE REBOUNDING

While Hope Foster has made headlines throughout her career by blocking shots, she is now drawing attention for her rebounding prowess. The senior cracked the Patriot League top-10 list for rebounding earlier this year and currently ranks eighth in conference history with 896 boards. Next up for her on the Patriot League career list is seventh-place Vicki Quimby, a former Bison, and her 902 career rebounds. Quimby is Bucknell's all-time leader in rebounding as well. Foster is averaging 7.2 rebounds per game this year, including 9.0 over the last seven contests.

CLOSE LOSSES

Bucknell finished the regular season in fifth place in the Patriot League, but with a couple of breaks, the Bison could have finished much higher. Bucknell's six Patriot League losses came by a total of 31 points and the widest margin it lost by was seven points.

FOSTER BETTER VS. PL

First Team All-Patriot League selection Hope Foster hit her stride during Patriot League play. After averaging 10.1 points and 6.9 rebounds per game and shooting 41.8 percent from the field in the 14 non-conference games, Foster registered a team-high 13.9 points and 7.2 rebounds per contest and shot 51.8 percent from the field against Patriot League foes during the regular season. She piled up 194 points in Patriot League play, 10 more than her total from last year when she was Patriot League Player of the Year.

SCORING DEFENSE IMPROVES IN PL PLAY

Bucknell limited opponents to less than 58 points per game each of the last two years to claim two of the top three spots on the program's scoring defense list. For most of this season opponents were scoring in the mid-60s, but that changed with the onset of Patriot League play. Patriot League foes averaged just 51.9 points per game, and that included three overtime contests. The Bison held 10 of their 17 conference opponents (includes PL Tournament) to 50 points or less. Bucknell's current overall scoring defense of 58.5

would rank fourth in program history, and third since 1980.

FRESHMEN STRONG ON THE BOARDS

Freshmen Cosima Higham and Joyce Novacek have come on strong in the latter part of this season. The duo has allowed Bison head coach Kathy Fedorjaka to utilize a three-person rotation at the power forward and center position. Novacek is tied for second on the team in rebounding, averaging 4.3. She has averaged more than eight rebounds per game when in the starting lineup. Higham is averaging 3.5 rebounds per contest despite seeing exactly 10 minutes of action per game. Both freshmen are also outstanding offensive rebounders. Novacek ranks second on the team with 44 offensive boards, while Higham is tied for third with 37. Higham has the same amount of offensive rebounds (37) as defensive (37).

CONSECUTIVE STARTS

Senior co-captain Kesha Champion has started 119 consecutive games. She broke the program record for consecutive starts that was held by Molly Creamer late in February.

.500 HOME RECORD

Bucknell's win March 1 against Army helped it improve to 7-6 at Sojka Pavilion this year. It is the 14th consecutive year the Bison have finished with a home record above .500.

NEUTRAL SITES

Since the current seniors were freshmen in 2004-05, Bucknell has posted a 4-5 record on neutral courts, including 1-0 this year.

THREE PLAYERS IN DOUBLE FIGURES

Bucknell has three players averaging in double figures this season with Hope Foster (11.4 ppg), Amanda Brown (11.2 ppg) and Kesha Champion (10.5) all pouring in better than 10 points per game. It is the first time a trio of Bison have done that since 2005-06. Those three veterans are among the top-11 scorers in the Patriot League this year. No other league team placed more than two players among the league's top 15 scorers.

LARGE CROWDS

Bucknell has had a total of 27,491 spectators watch it play this year. The last time the Bison had more fans watch their games, home and away, was 2002-03 when 29,293 people went through the turnstiles. Bucknell has played in front of crowds of at least 1,000 on seven occasions this year, two more than last year's total.

PATRIOT LEAGUE WINS FOR FEDORJAKA

Bucknell head coach Kathy Fedorjaka wrapped up the regular season with 90 career Patriot League wins. That figure is tied with Lehigh's Sue Troyan for second place in Patriot League history. However, Fedorjaka's .616 PL winning percentage is much better than Troyan's .529. In Patriot League Tournament play, Fedorjaka has posted an 11-9 record.

FIVE-BLOCK GAMES FOR FOSTER

In the regular-season finale against Army, Hope Foster blocked five shots. She has registered 22 of the 30 five-block games in Bucknell history. In those 22 contests where she has accumulated at least five rejections, she has piled up 129 blocks. That figure alone would rank second on the Bison career list (excluding Foster), just three behind Marie Kocornik.

Bucknell head coach Kathy Fedorjaka has used nine starting lineups this season. She used six different lineups in the season's first six games and then started all five seniors for the first time last Saturday against Army to make it nine lineups in 28 regular-season games. The only time a Bison team used more starting lineups during the regular season was in 1991-92 when they had 13 different starting units. The 1981-82, 1983-84 and 1992-93 squads also had nine different starting lineups during the regular season.

STRONGER IN SECOND HALF

Despite having four players averaging at least 30 minutes per game, Bucknell has played its best basketball in the second half this season. The Bison have outscored opponents by 41 points in the second half this year. They hold just a five-point advantage in the first half.

PLAYING WELL INTO MARCH

Last year Bucknell played its final game of the season on March 15, equaling the 2002 team for the latest date to wrap up a season in program history. The Bison will eclipse that by more than one week this year.

UP NEXT

If Bucknell pulls off the second-ever No. 16 over No. 1 upset in NCAA Tournament history, it will face the winner of the No. 8 Georgia vs. No. 9 Iowa contest that is played at 2:30 p.m. Sunday in Norfolk, Va.


