ABOUT THE GAME

Bucknell will welcome in the month of March with the Patriot League Tournament Quarterfinals at Bethlehem, Pa., on Thursday. The seventh-seeded Bison will hit the road looking for an upset over No. 2 Lehigh with tip-off set for 7 p.m. On Feb. 15, the last time Bucknell made the trip to Bethlehem, it walked away with a 62-56 victory, ending a 10-game losing streak to the Mountain Hawks.

WITH A VICTORY OVER LEHIGH, BUCKNELL WOULD...

- Advance to the Patriot League Tournament semifinals to face the winner of No. 3 Navy vs. No. 6 Colgate.
- Advance to the Patriot League Tournament Semifinals for a second consecutive year.
- Improve to 2-3 against the Mountain Hawks in the postseason.
- Win back-to-back games over the Mountain Hawks for the first time since 2007.

QUICK FACTS

- Bucknell is 0-4 when playing a postseason game at Stabler Arena, but only one of those losses is to Lehigh (2005).
- Bucknell led the Patriot League in rebounding defense (32.9), rebounding margin (+2.7) and free throw percentage (.750) during the regular season.
- With four blocked shots vs. Holy Cross on Feb. 18, Bucknell reached 100 rejections for the year. The Bison now rank 10th in the program's single-season history at 104.
- Shelby Romine was named Patriot League Anaconda Player of the Week on Feb. 13. She followed the award with her second consecutive 20-point game (23 at Lehigh) on Feb. 15.
- Bucknell has lost eight games by four or fewer points, and three by a single point, this year. Its first four wins were by double digits.
- Shelby Romine became the first current Bison to 500 career points when the Bison played Yale on Jan. 3. She then hit 600 at Lafayette on Feb. 11 and is currently at 663. Rachel Voss became the second to 500 at Army and is currently at 556 points.
- Of Horbatuck's 473 career rebounds, 42.7 percent (202) are off the offensive glass.

LAST MEETING WITH LEHIGH - FEB. 15, 2012

- Bucknell 62, Lehigh 56 (Stabler Arena)
- Spurred by 23 points from Shelby Romine and a second consecutive double-double from Lindsay Horbatuck, Bucknell defeated Lehigh 62-56 on the road and snapped a 10-game losing streak to the Mountain Hawks. Thanks to a strong start to the game for the Bison, the victory came despite going the final 6:12 without a field goal.
- Horbatuck finished the day with 13 points and 10 rebounds. The junior was 4-for-5 from the floor on the night, but equally important was her 5-for-6 performance from the free throw line. During its more than six minutes without a field goal, Bucknell relied on its free throw shooting down the final stretch. While the Bison showed some shakiness as a team from the line, Horbatuck hit the final two attempts to put her team up 62-56 with 10 seconds remaining.
- The Bison led by 12 points at halftime and 19 points early in the second half, but heading into the game's final two minutes Bucknell's advantage had shrunk to 58-52. Putting the Bison in the tight spot was Lehigh's defense that pressured Bucknell into several late turnovers. The Bison misplayed the ball six times in the final 5:40, and Lehigh's Emily Gratch earned four steals in a 1:16 span during that stretch.
- Scrappy play held Lehigh to .358 shooting (19-53) for the game. That same play gave Bucknell a 22-12 rebounding advantage at halftime. The Bison finished the night with a 44-27 advantage on the glass.

HISTORY VS. LEHIGH

- Lehigh is 39-31 all-time, including 21-13 at Stabler Arena, against Bucknell. The Bison are averaging 64.2 points in all 34 games in Bethlehem, but that drops to 52.2 points per game in the last five trips.
- Bucknell is 17-9 all-time when it holds Lehigh to fewer than 60 points. However, four of the last five games in which the Mountain Hawks scored fewer than 60 points went in Lehigh's favor. The one exception was Feb. 15, 2012 when the Bison earned the 62-56 victory.
- Bucknell went nearly four years between double-doubles against Lehigh. Hope Foster tallied 14 points and 13 rebounds on Feb. 27, 2008. Lindsay Horbatuck then broke the streak with a 13 point-10 rebound performance on Feb. 15, 2012.

HISTORY VS. LEHIGH IN THE PATRIOT LEAGUE TOURNAMENT

- Lehigh leads Bucknell 3-1 in the Patriot League Tournament. All four of those meetings came in the quarterfinals.
- Lehigh has outscored Bucknell 59.8 to 57.3 in Patriot League Tournament games.
- The higher seed has won in three of four postseason meetings between Bucknell and Lehigh. The lone exception was in 1998 when the fifth-seeded Mountain Hawks upset the No. 4 Bison by four points.
- The first two Patriot League Tournament meetings were decided by four or fewer points, with both games going in Lehigh's favor. The teams' last two meetings were decided by 10 or more points.
- Bucknell has led Lehigh at halftime in two of their postseason games, including 32-30 in 2010. The Bison have outscored the Mountain Hawks in the second half on three postseason occasions.
- After scoring 19 points in the first half, Joyce Novacek tallied a career-high 24 against Lehigh on March 6, 2010. Then a junior, she shot 10-for-11 from the field. Her 24 points is tied for third-most by a Bison in a Patriot League Tournament game.
- Bucknell has had one player with 20-plus points in each of the last three tournament games against Lehigh - Novacek (24 points in 2010), Lindsey Hollobaugh (23 points in 2005), Kesha Champion (20 points in 2006).

BUCKNELL VS. LEHIGH IN 2012

Bucknell and Lehigh split decisions during the 2012 regular season, and each team won on the road. The Mountain Hawks claimed victory in January, 53-38, at Sojka Pavilion, while the Bison were 62-56 winners at Stabler Arena in February. claimed the No. 2 seed, and the fourth consecutive season at No. 2 or higher, in the conference tournament.

Alexa Williams was named First Team All-Patriot League on Tuesday. The senior forward averaged 14.3 points and 8.4 rebounds during league action. She is joined by Emily Gratch (12.6 ppg) and Kelly Peterson (11.4) among the team's high scorers against Patriot League foes. Gratch is also second in the Patriot League in field goal percentage (.528) and fourth in steals (2.0).

VOSS VOTED ACADEMIC ALL-LEAGUE

Rachel Voss was named to the Academic All-Patriot League Team on Tuesday. The junior forward has a 3.80 cumulative grade-point average while majoring in business administration and Spanish. Off the court, Voss has been named to the Patriot League Academic Honor Roll and Bucknell Dean's List multiple times. A member of Mortar Board Gamma Beta Chapter, she also serves as a teaching assistant for Management 101 classes at Bucknell.

On the court, Voss averaged 9.9 points and 4.7 rebounds in Patriot League play. She scored her 500th career point earlier this season when the Bison took on Army at West Point. Voss has led Bucknell in scoring a team-best seven times this season and reached double-figure points a career-high 11 times.

THAT WAS VERY OFFENSIVE

Bucknell returned to the plus side of the rebounding margin for the first time in three games when it took a 35-32 edge over Navy on Saturday. The Bison had 18 offensive boards and 17 defensive in the matchup. The last time Bucknell claimed a majority of its rebounds on the offensive glass was at Holy Cross on Feb. 13, 2010. The Bison finished with 27 on the offensive boards compared to 19 on the defensive. Bucknell outrebounded the Crusaders 46-25 in that contest but lost by a score of 65-60.

SHUTTING IT DOWN WITH DEFENSE

- If the season were to end today, Bucknell's 59.0 scoring defense mark would tie for fifth in program history equaling the average points allowed by the 1974-75 and 1979-80 Bison squads.
- Bucknell's 59.0 scoring defense is the best since the 2006-07 team allowed just 56.1 points per game. That mark currently stands as the school record.
- Bucknell has finished the season with a scoring defense of 60.0 points or less in six of the last seven years.
- In the 2012 series with Lehigh, Bucknell allowed 53 and 56 points to the Mountain Hawks. The Bison's 54.5 points allowed against Lehigh this season is the fewest since they gave up 45.0 points per game in 2007. Bucknell won over Lehigh 64-37 and 63-53 in those two matchups. That stretch also marked the last time the Bison won back-to-back games against the Mountain Hawks.

ASSIST 22

Christina Chukwuedo recorded four of her highest single-game assists totals this season. The senior dished out eight against Youngstown State in November, seven at Lehigh on Feb. 15 and six at both Lafayette and Navy. She has nine games with five or more assists and has led Bucknell in the stat 15 times this season.

Bucknell accomplished a lot with its 62-56 win over Lehigh on Feb. 15. With the victory, the Bison ...

- Snapped a 10-game losing streak to the Mountain Hawks. It was Bucknell's first win over Lehigh since Feb. 20, 2007.

- Earned their 150th Patriot League win. Bucknell is now 150-142 in regular-season conference play.
- Won their third straight game for the first time this season.
- Won back-to-back games on the road for the first time since January 2011.
- Moved ahead of Lafayette into a tie for sixth place in the Patriot League standings at 3-8.

LOOKING FOR, AND FINDING, BIGGER NUMBERS VS. LEHIGH

Lehigh has held Bucknell to some low scoring numbers in recent years. Before the Feb. 15 game, Lindsay Horbatuck and Alyssa Dunn were the only current Bison to reach double-figure scoring in a single game vs. the Mountain Hawks. Horbatuck totaled 11 on Jan. 26, 2011, and Dunn had 10 on Jan. 18, 2012. Bucknell's leading scorer, Shelby Romine, was averaging just 6.0 points in three games against Lehigh with her highest single-game scoring output being seven points on two occasions. That all changed on Feb. 15 when Romine tallied 23 points against the Mountain Hawks. Horbatuck added 13 points and Rachel Voss had 11. It was the first time three Bison scored in double figures against Lehigh since Joyce Novacek (24 points), Cosima Higham (11) and Trisha Krewson (10) in the Patriot League Tournament Quarterfinals on March 6, 2010.

FLIP FLOPPING

Bucknell earned one of its biggest leads of the year when it went up by 19 at Lehigh on Feb. 15. The only time the Bison had a larger advantage was against Colgate on Feb. 8 when they went up by 27 at one point. More impressive, however, was the turnaround from the first meeting between Bucknell and Lehigh. When the two teams squared off in January, Lehigh's largest lead was 15 points with :06 remaining in the second half, while Bucknell's was six points with 12:23 in the first. In February, Lehigh led by no more than four with 18:33 left in the first half. Bucknell's 19-point advantage came at 14:04 in the second.

ANOTHER 60-POINT STAT

One key to snapping Bucknell's 10-game losing streak to Lehigh on Feb. 15 was undoubtedly its ability to put the ball in the basket. The Bison scored 60 points only once during that 10-game span - a 69-60 loss on Feb. 25, 2009. Not including Feb. 15, the last time Bucknell scored more than 60 points was on Feb. 20, 2007, the game before the losing streak began. The Bison won that contest 63-53. The Mountain Hawks score 60 or more points six times during their 10-game run.

SEEING 20-20

Shelby Romine totaled more than 20 points in back-to-back games against Lafayette and Lehigh. It is the second time in her career that the sophomore has recorded consecutive outings at 20-plus. TAKING BACK CONTROL

A lot of things changed between the two games in which Bucknell and American squared off. Among them were turnovers and points off turnovers. In January, the Bison turned the ball over a season-high 33 times, and the Eagles had the 38-8 advantage in points off turnovers. In February, Bucknell recorded just 15 miscues, giving it the second-lowest total of the season. Points off turnovers swung in favor of the Bison as well, 17-14. American totaled 14 turnovers in January and 12 on Feb. 22.

MAKING A SWITCH

After going 18 games with the same starting lineup, the Bison switched things up a bit against American and Navy. Alyssa Dunn moved into the starting five, while Felicia Mgbada became the Sixth Man. The last time Bucknell used an identical lineup - Dunn, Shelby Romine, Christina Chukwuedo, Rachel Voss, Lindsay Horbatuck - was Dec. 3 at NJIT. The change in roles appeared to agree with Dunn and Mgbada in both games. TRAILING EARLY OR LEADING LATE

Bucknell was never able to gain a lead against American on Jan. 25. It was the fifth game this season, but just the second time on the road, that the Bison trailed the entire 40 minutes. It was also the third consecutive game at Bender Arena in which Bucknell never gained the scoring advantage. That trend against the Eagles is different when the two play in Lewisburg. Including their late five-point advantage on Feb. 22, the Bison have had a second-half or overtime lead in 11 of the last 13 home games and have won five of those meetings. No information was available for the 1983 game, which Bucknell lost 77-72.

SO CLOSE

Bucknell suffered its third one-point loss of the season on Jan. 28 when it fell 50-49 to Navy. The Bison's other one-point losses came against Youngstown State (57-56) on Nov. 16 and NJIT (54-53) on Dec. 3. It is the first time in program history that Bucknell has lost three games by one point in a single season. Prior to this winter, Bucknell's last defeat by a single point came against Iona on Jan. 3, 2007 by a score of 45-44.

STRONG DOWN THE STRETCH

Juniors Rachel Voss and Alyssa Dunn might have taken a bit of time to get rolling this season, but the wait has been worth it. Voss has improved her scoring game by at least two points during each nine-game increment, and Dunn's average has followed a similar trend.

FREEBIES FOR DUNN

Alyssa Dunn has turned the offensive corner as the season has gone on, and one place in which her progress is clear on the free throw line. The junior is shooting .875 (28-for-32) during Patriot League play, which ranks second in the conference standings behind teammate Lindsay Horbatuck (.900). Dunn's percentage is also an improvement from her .643 (18-for-28) during non-conference action. She recently shot 8-for-8 from the charity stripe against American, setting a career high in free throws made.

In her career, Dunn entered the season shooting .490 (25-for-51) from the free throw line. This season alone, she is at .767 (46-for-60).

LOVING THE DOUBLE-DOUBLE

By putting up 12 points and 12 rebounds against Holy Cross on Feb. 18, Lindsay Horbatuck recorded her third consecutive double-double. She is the first Bison since Desire Almind in 2003-04 to record at least three straight double-doubles. Almind, who finished the 2003-04 campaign with a Bucknell record-17 double-doubles, had four in a row twice during that season. Bucknell went 2-2 during each of those stretches. THEY DIDN'T FOUL

Bucknell and Holy Cross combined for 17 team fouls and, as a result, shot just 8-for-10 from the free throw line on Feb. 18. The Bison were 4-for-6, while the Crusaders were 4-for-4. Holy Cross is the second Bucknell opponent to go perfect from the line at Sojka Pavilion, joining Navy's 6-for-6 performance on Feb. 9, 2008. Holy Cross' four free throw attempts was the fewest allowed by Bucknell this season.

HORBATUCK DOUBLES IT UP ... AGAIN

Lindsay Horbatuck recorded her seventh double-double of the season when she posted 12 points and 12 rebounds against Holy Cross on Feb. 18. The junior also has double-doubles against Saint Francis (Pa.), Fordham, Colgate, American, Lafayette and Lehigh this winter. Of her eight career double-doubles, only two have played out at Sojka Pavilion, the 12 point-14 rebound performance against Fordham on Dec. 6 and the most recent performance against Holy Cross.

PUTTING THE BALL THROUGH THE NET

Lindsay Horbatuck has always been efficient offensively, and she is now being recognized for it. Heading into the Feb. 22 game against American, the junior forward led the Patriot League in both field goal (.544; 43-79) and free throw (.889; 32-36) percentage. Horbatuck is now shooting .494 from the field for her career, giving her the highest mark on the team.

LEADING US TO VICTORY

Bucknell has won its games this year in varying fashion. It has held large leads and small leads, come from behind and fought off late attacks. Four different Bison have earned the title of leading scorer in those victories. Four different players have been the top steals getter. The most consistent piece in the wins puzzle has been Lindsay Horbatuck, who has led the team in rebounding each time out and is averaging 12.2 boards per win.

HOSTING ANOTHER BLOCK PARTY

With two blocked shots against Navy on Jan. 28, Felicia Mgbada broke into the program's top 10 with her 63rd career rejection. She now ranks 10th all-time at Bucknell after passing Julie Bachman, who played with the Bison from 1986-87 and 1989-91.

Mgbada isn't the only Bison racking up the blocks this season. Along with Rachel Voss, Alyssa Dunn and Lindsay Horbatuck, the junior quartet has totaled 66 rejections accounting for 63.5 percent of the team's blocks.

HOW'D SHE DO THAT?

Shelby Romine totaled a season-high 26 points at Lafayette on Feb. 11 and 23 more points the following game at Lehigh. The sophomore now has nine career 20-point games, all of which have obviously come with superior shooting. In those nine contests, the guard is shooting .470 from the field, including .583 from behind the 3-point arc, and .823 from the free throw line.

BOUNCING BACK IN A BIG WAY

Bucknell recovered from a halftime deficit for the first time this season when it went from four points down mid-way through the game to 11 points ahead at the final buzzer in its 65-54 win at Lafayette on Feb. 11. The Leopards had led by as many as 14 points with 7:50 remaining in the first half. The Bison then outscored Lafayette 56-31 for the rest of the game.

ROMINE'S 600-200

Shelby Romine reached a pair of career milestones on Feb. 11 at Lafayette. The sophomore guard scored her 617th career point and grabbed her 202nd career rebounds. She is the first current Bison to surpass the 600-point mark and the 33rd in program history. Romine currently stands at 663 points.

BUCKNELL 500

With her seven points against Yale on Jan. 3 - the 43rd game of her career - Shelby Romine brought her career scoring total to 504. The last Bison who needed fewer than 43 games to reach 500 points was Lindsey Hollobaugh. Hollobaugh reached 500 in her 31st career game, scoring 13 points against Texas A&M. It was the second outing of her sophomore season. Bucknell's all-time leading scorer Molly Creamer reached 500 points in her 32nd career game, also the second contest of her sophomore season.

BIG ON THE BOARDS

Bucknell showed off its hustle play on Feb. 8 when it outrebounded Colgate 58-33. The Bison's 58 boards was a season high and set a Sojka Pavilion record. Their 23 offensive rebounds and 35 defensive rebounds were also the most in a single game this winter.

The last time Bucknell grabbed 58 rebounds was on Jan. 18, 2002 at American. The last time the Bison finished with at least 50 rebounds was earlier this year when they totaled 51 against Morgan State.

THAT GLASS IS SQUEAKY CLEAN

Bucknell tied a school record on Feb. 4 vs. Army, holding its opponent to just 18 total rebounds. The mark equaled the 18 allowed to Holy Cross on March 6, 2002 when the Bison defeated the Crusaders for their first-ever Patriot League Championship. Bucknell limited Army to four offensive rebounds and 14 defensive boards.

MORE NOTES ON REBOUNDING

- Bucknell has set both the Sojka Pavilion high and low records in rebounds this season. After being held to just 25 boards against Army on Jan. 7, the Bison "rebounded" for 58 boards against Colgate on Feb. 8.
- Before taking on Colgate on Feb. 8, Bucknell had a -1.0 rebounding margin in Patriot League play. After that game when they outrebounded the Raiders by 25, the Bison improved that margin to +1.3.
- In two games with Colgate this year, Lindsay Horbatuck averaged 14.0 rebounds. The junior has 7.3 boards per game in her career vs. the Raiders. As a team, Bucknell posted a +16.5 rebounding margin against Colgate this year.
- Bucknell has outrebounded its last seven opponents by a combined 275-212 (+9.0). Lindsay Horbatuck is averaging 10.3 boards in those seven outings.
- Bucknell outrebounded Army by a season-best 17 on Feb. 4, 35-18. It was the fourth time this winter the Bison had a positive double-figure rebounding margin. The list has grown to six opponents and also includes Saint Peter's (+14), Morgan State (+15), Niagara (+12), Colgate (+25) and Lehigh (+17).
- When it comes to Patriot League play, Lindsay Horbatuck has more defensive rebounds (80) than any other Bison has total rebounds. She also has more offensive rebounds (52) than all but one other Bison. Rachel Voss has 66 total boards in league play.
- Lindsay Horbatuck has led Bucknell in rebounding in each of the last 11 games and in 12 of the last 13. She has recorded the team's high in boards 21 times this season. No other Bison has led more than three times.

BENCH MARKS

Before breaking back into the starting lineup vs. American on Feb. 22, Alyssa Dunn had been Bucknell's main bright spot when it came to production off the bench. Although the guard had nine points in her only other start of the season at NJIT on Dec. 3 and added 20 points against the Eagles, much of Dunn's success has come as the sixth man.

- In Patriot League games in which she comes off the bench, Dunn has 103 points, or 65.2 percent, of the team's reserve scoring. The rest of the Bison backups had 55 points.
- Dunn had 20 of Bucknell's 24 points off the bench against American, Army and Navy. The junior tallied a season-best 14 points against Army on Feb. 4 and two points against Navy on Jan. 28. No other Bison bench player scored in either contest. Dunn was also the only reserve to tally points against Holy Cross on Feb. 18.
- Four times during Patriot League play, Dunn has outscored Bucknell's opponent's bench. Twice that opponent was Army, 14-13 on Feb. 4 and 5-4 in January. The third was on Feb. 8 against Colgate, 12-6, and the last came 13-5 against Holy Cross of Feb. 18. Felicia Mgbada became the second Bison to earn that distinction when she moved into a reserve role on Feb. 22 against American. Mgbada totaled 10 points, while the Eagles' bench had four.
- Bucknell has been outscored 207-178 in bench points during Patriot League play and 498-401 overall for the season.

THE DIFFERENCE MAKER

Bucknell benefited from a solid team effort to recover from a 14-point deficit in the first half at Lafayette on Feb. 11, but the statistical differ-

ence turned out to be just two 3-pointers and five foul shots, totaling 11 points. Bucknell eventually won by 11 points, 65-54. Both teams hit 19 two-point field goals, but Bucknell was 4-for-7 from 3-point range compared to 2-for-10 for Lafayette. The Bison also outpaced their opponent from the free throw line, shooting 15-for-17. The Leopards were 10-for-13 from the line.

Entering the Feb. 11 game, Bucknell was making just 1.5 three-point field goals and 8.8 free throws per game. Lafayette was at 2.3 three-pointers and 12.1 free throws.

SOMETHING IN COMMON

Bucknell's first three wins this season all had several things in common. In each of those victories - vs. Saint Peter's, Fordham and Colgate - the Bison were ...

- Leading at halftime and still outscored their opponent in the second half.
- Held their opponent to less than 40 percent shooting.
- Held their opponent to fewer than 60 points.
- Scored more bench points and more second-chance points than their opponent.
- Recorded at least twice as many assists as their opponent.
- Get at least 10 rebounds from Lindsay Horbatuck. Horbatuck had 11 boards vs. Saint Peter's, 14 vs. Fordham and 16 vs. Colgate. She is averaging 10.0 points and 13.7 rebounds in wins.

SCORING BREAKTHROUGH

Bucknell set season highs in field goals made (29), field goals attempted (69), first-half points scored (41) and total points (67) against Colgate on Feb. 8. The Bison's 67 total points scored eclipsed their previous high of 66, which also came against the Raiders in January.

FUN WITH RANDOM STATS

- Bucknell's starters tied Colgate, 45-45, in the game. The Bison starters also outrebounded all Raiders, 38-33.
- Despite committing more turnovers than Colgate, Bucknell outscored the Raiders 20-1 on points off turnovers. The Raiders committed 15 miscues, compared to 19 for the Bison.
- Lindsay Horbatuck had more offensive rebounds (9) than any one individual Colgate player had total rebounds (Jhazmine Lynch, 8). As a team, the Raiders had 12 offensive boards.
- With 13:18 in the second half, Bucknell led by 27 points. It was the Bison's largest lead of the season.
- Bucknell was 1-for-17 (.059) in 3-point field goals in its first three wins this year - 0-5 vs. Saint Peter's, 1-6 vs. Fordham and 0-6 vs. Colgate.

BUCKNELL FOR THREE

When the Bison won three consecutive games in mid-February, it was the first time they had strung together a trio of victories in nearly a year. During its most recent run, Bucknell earned decisions over Colgate (Feb. 8), Lafayette (Feb. 11) and Lehigh (Feb. 15). The Bison defeated Holy Cross (Feb. 12), Lafayette (Feb. 16) and Colgate (Feb. 19) consecutively in 2011.

The last time Bucknell won more than three in a row was in December/January of the 2008-09 season.

FIVE IN DOUBLES

Five Bison finished in double-figure scoring on Jan. 11 at Colgate - Shelby Romine (19 points), Lindsay Horbatuck (13), Felicia Mgbada (10), Alyssa Dunn (10) and Micki Impellizeri (10). The last time Bucknell put five players in double digits was Feb. 9, 2008 when it defeated Navy 65-50 at Sojka Pavilion.

It has also been quite some time since Bucknell finished with five double-digit scorers but suffered a loss. The Bison fell 67-63 in overtime to Holy Cross on Jan. 14, 2006 despite the point production from Lauren Schober (18), Lindsey Hollobaugh (12), Keshia Champion (11), Hope Foster (10) and Amanda Brown (10).

BRODERICK BECOMES INTERIM HEAD COACH

On Jan. 13 Bucknell women's basketball coach Kathy Fedorjaka announced her resignation, effective immediately. Assistant coach Bill Broderick has assumed additional responsibilities to lead the program on an interim basis, and a national search will take place at season's end to identify the program's next head coach.

Fedorjaka was in her 15th season as head coach at Bucknell, making her the longest-tenured head coach in program history. She guided the Bison to three 20-win seasons and Patriot League championships in 2002 and 2008. She departs with a record of 209-211 at Bucknell.

Broderick is in his second year as an assistant coach at Bucknell. Prior to Bucknell, he served as an assistant coach at Elon (2008-10), Pittsburgh (1998-2002), Arizona (1995-98), Frostburg State (1994-95) and Potomac State (1992-94), in addition to a head coaching stint in the high school ranks in Northern Virginia.

UP NEXT

Should the Bison advance to the Patriot League Tournament Semifinals, they will take on the winner of No. 3 Navy vs. No. 6 Colgate. The semifinal game will take place at the site of the higher seed.
