### About the Match...

The Bucknell women's soccer team will take on Penn State tonight on Jeffrey Field at 5 p.m. The Nittany Lions are one of four No. 1 seeds in this year's NCAA Tournament. Bucknell, which is undefeated in its last four games (3-0-1), is 11-8-1 overall on the season and is coming off a 3-1 win over Army in the Patriot League Championship match. The victory over the Black Knights earned the Orange and Blue an automatic bid into the NCAA Tournament. The Lions were knocked out of the Big Ten Tournament on Nov. 3, by Michigan, falling 4-2 in penalty kicks after playing through regulation and two overtimes to a 3-3 tie. Penn State is 19-0-1 overall on the year and was ranked No. 2 in this week's Soccer Buzz top 30.

### About the Series...

Bucknell is 0-9-0 all-time against Penn State since the teams first met on Sept. 27, 1994. The last time the squads met was on Sept. 14, 2004, when the Nittany Lions came away with a 5-0 victory. Bucknell's last goal against Penn State came on Nov. 16, 2001, when the Lions defeated the Bison, 3-1 in the NCAA Tournament First Round.

### Bucknell Captures League Title with 3-1 Victory over Army...

Bucknell became the first No. 4 seed in history to win the Patriot League women's soccer championship, as the Bison scored three times in the second half to defeat the Black Knights of Army by a 3-1 margin in the Patriot League title game at Lehigh's Ulrich Sports Complex on Sunday, Nov. 6. Bucknell improved to 11-8-1 on the season and captured its second Patriot League championship, with the first coming back in the 2001 season. The teams played a scoreless first half with few offensive opportunities allowed by either defense. Army threatened in the 13th minute, but Leigh Kosco missed on a crossing shot. Bucknell then narrowly missed going up 1-0 at the start of the second half, but the header attempt by sophomore Krista Lee Gentile glanced off the crossbar. Finally 60:10 into the match, freshman Nicole Marotta broke the 0-0 deadlock as she found the back of the Black Knights' goal off a corner kick from junior co-captain Shannon Curd. Curd was named Tournament MVP for her efforts in both of Bucknell's games on the weekend as she netted the lone Bison goal on Friday evening against Lehigh and had the deciding penalty kick in that match before assisting on Marotta's goal for her third point of the tournament. Army managed to erase the one-goal deficit at 65:30 when Jessica Congemi lofted a shot over the head of Bucknell goalkeeper Katie Dry for her first of the season. This did not deter the Bison, however, as Gentile netted her 11th goal of the year on a cross from senior Caitlin Lanctot in the 75th minute to give Bucknell back the lead at 2-1. Senior Kerry Fitz-Patrick went on to cement the victory for the Orange and Blue as she fired the ball from the left side off a feed from freshman Jennifer Dervarics and into the Black Knights' goal.

### Bison Knock Off No. 1 Seed Lehigh in Patriot League Semis...

Junior co-captain Shannon Curd scored and notched the deciding tally in a shootout to help lift the Bucknell women's soccer team past Lehigh, 6-5 in penalty kicks, in the Patriot League Semifinal on Friday evening, Nov. 4. The teams played to a 1-1 draw after two overtimes and the game's outcome was recorded as a tie. Bucknell moved to 10-8-1 on the season in its first Patriot League postseason appearance and victory in the tournament since winning the championship in 2001. The Bison jumped out in front, 1-0, at 33:52 when senior Kerry Fitz-Patrick fed a cross in front to Curd who deposited the ball into the back of the net. The tally marked just the fifth goal scored against the Mountain Hawks all season. Lehigh came out pressuring after the intermission, however, and opened the second half with several quality scoring chances. Bison netminder Katie Dry made a save in a crowd in front off a free kick, then broke up a partial breakaway by Melissa Montalvo in the 60th minute. The Mountain Hawks eventually capitalized on the pressure in the 64th minute when Gina Lewandowski tipped the ball over Dry's head off a feed from Meghan Duesing to tie the score at one. The Bison made their first four penalty kick attempts while the Mountain Hawks converted on three of their first four. Bucknell looked to clinch the shootout victory on its fifth shot, but Brittany Besler turned aside the attempt by sophomore Lindsey Appenzoller.

Both squads went on to miss their sixth attempts and made their seventh before Curd found the back of the net on the Bison's eighth attempt. This proved to be the deciding tally as Dry stopped Lehigh's final kick by Hailey Coonrad.

#### A Year to Remember...

In 2005, Bucknell posted a 10-8-0 record in the regular season with a 4-3-0 record in league matches for the program's best mark since winning the Patriot League title in 2001 with a mark of 12-7-0 (4-3-0 PL). The 2005 Bison squad is just the third team in program history to win more than 10 games in a season and more than doubled scoring production from the year before. Bucknell has 115 points as a team in 2005 with 41 goals and 33 assists after posting 51 points on 19 goals and 13 assists in 2004.

#### Bison in the Patriot League Tournament...

In the program's 16-year history, the Bison qualified for the Patriot League Tournament on nine occasions and are 4-8 in tournament play. Bucknell is undefeated in its last four League tournament games after advancing past Lehigh on penalty kicks on Friday, Nov. 4, defeating Army, 3-1 in the championship on Sunday, Nov. 6, and posting two victories in its last trip to the Patriot League Tourney four years ago. Bucknell claimed wins by 2-1 margins over American and Navy in 2001, en-route to its first league championship.

#### Scouting Bucknell...

Junior Jennifer Margolis currently leads the Bison with 13 goals and three assists for 29 points. She finished first in the Patriot League in game-winning goals with six this season, tied for first in goals and goals per game, ranked second in points per game (1.61) and third in points. Margolis' stellar season has landed her in the Bucknell record books as well. She is currently tied for fifth on the career goals list with 21, is sixth in career points with 52, is fourth on the single season goals list and tied for fifth for points in a season. Bucknell sophomore Krista Lee Gentile is second on the team in goals with 11 and points with 28. She is also tied for the team lead in assists with classmate Leslie Schulze as both players have six assists on the year. Like Margolis, Gentile has propelled into the Bison all-time scoring lists this season as well. She is seventh and ninth in single season goals and points, respectively, and is eighth in career goals with 18 and ninth in career points with 43. Junior netminder Katie Dry has started the last 11 games in goal for Bucknell with 16 total on the season for 1446:29 minutes and a record of 9-6-1. She has made 67 saves on the year with a season-high 10 stops in a victory over Cornell and has a goals against average of 1.62 with one shutout during her junior campaign.

#### Scouting Penn State...

Tiffany Weimer leads the Nittany Lions in goals with 26 and in points with 56. She ranked fifth in the last NCAA statistics report with 2.80 points per game and third with 1.30 goals per game. Carmelina Moscato has a team-best eight assists and ranks second on the squad in points with 22. Erin McLeod has played in 19 games, starting all 19, for a total of 1717:18 minutes. She has allowed 16 goals for a goals against average of 0.84. She has a record of 18-0-1 and has made 64 saves on the year.

#### Welcome Aboard...

Just the third head coach in the history of the women's soccer program, Ben Landis, a 1996 graduate of Bucknell, is in his first season as head coach of the Bison. Landis started his coaching career at Bucknell as a student assistant coach under Toby Lovecchio in 1994 and 1995 and continued as an assistant the following fall after graduating. Most recently, the Breinigsville, Pa., native held the women's soccer head coaching position at Dartmouth. In two seasons at the helm of the program, Landis led the Big Green to a 16-12-6 record. In 2003, Dartmouth won the Ivy League with a 9-6-2 record and earned a berth in the NCAA Tournament. Prior to taking over as head coach, Landis was an assistant at Dartmouth for three seasons. The Big Green qualified for the NCAA Tournament each year and finished the 2001 campaign ranked 13th in the country. They also finished 16th nationally in 2000 and advanced to the third round of the NCAA Tournament in both 2000 and 2001.

#### Home Sweet Home...

On Tuesday, Aug. 30, Bucknell broke in its new field on a high note with a 7-1 victory over Howard. The seven goals marked the highest total by a Bison squad since the team posted a 9-0 shutout of Delaware State at home on Sept. 11, 2002. Coincidentally, the last time the team scored seven goals was also against Howard at home on Aug. 31, 2002. Bucknell continued the new Varsity Soccer Field celebration with a 3-2 win over Marist in the field's dedication game and posted a 7-2-0 record at home in 2005.

#### Bison Receive All-League Honors...

Two Bucknell women's soccer players were named to the two All-Patriot League teams, the Patriot League office announced on Thursday, Nov. 3. Junior forward Jennifer Margolis was selected to the all-league first team, as voted on by the Patriot League head women's soccer coaches, and sophomore Krista Lee Gentile earned a spot as one of the second team forwards.

#### Fitz-Patrick and Curd Named Academic All-District...

Bucknell midfielders senior Kerry Fitz-Patrick and junior Shannon Curd were named to the ESPN The Magazine 2005 Academic All-District II University Division Women's Soccer First Team. The pair becomes the second and third Bucknell players in program history to earn spots on the all-district first team as Lauren Schwarz was the first Bison named to the District II First-Team in 2003. As a sophomore, Fitz-Patrick was honored an all-district second team selection. Fitz-Patrick is an accounting major with a minor in mathematics and has a GPA of 3.86. Curd is double majoring in education and psychology and has a 3.91 GPA.

## #5 - Krista Lee Gentile - Brine Offensive Player of the Week 9/27 & 11/1

Bucknell women's soccer sophomore forward Krista Lee Gentile was named Brine Offensive Player of the Week by the Patriot League office on Tuesday, Sept. 27. The league honor marked Gentile's third of her career and was the first for a member of the

Bucknell squad this season. As a freshman, Gentile was a two-time Patriot League Rookie of the Week. Gentile earned the award after helping the Bison defeat Saint Francis (Pa.), 3-2, for their fourth straight win. She scored the first goal of the match just 4:29 into the contest against the Red Flash and later notched the deciding goal on a penalty kick in the 58th minute. Gentile's first goal of the contest gave Bucknell a 2-0 advantage as she scored on a breakaway from freshman Nicole Marotta at 18:17. She scored again at 49:57 on a cross from senior Beth Darby before completing the hat trick with the game-winner on a penalty kick in the 88th minute.

Bucknell women's soccer junior forward Jennifer Margolis was named Brine Offensive Player of the Week by the Patriot League office on Tuesday, Oct. 18.
