

## FACILITIES

### Christy Mathewson Memorial Stadium

The CMMS athletic training Room is located on the East side of the Stadium. Access to this facility may be made by entering through the door labeled "BISON FOOTBALL". The athletic training room is located immediately to your left. The athletic training room will open 2 1/2 hours prior to each home game.

### Sports Medicine Center

The Sports Medicine Center is located in the back of Davis Gymnasium. Access is through the main entrance of the Kenneth Langone Athletics and Recreation Center into the newer portion of Davis Gym. The Sports Medicine Center will be open two hours prior to a scheduled event, and will close approximately one hour after the event.

### Holmes Stadium

The Holmes Stadium athletic training room is located at the West Fields facility and is on the north side of the Stadium adjacent to the home team room. The Holmes ATR is open by request of visiting team athletic trainer or one hour prior to scheduled event. A hydroculator and ice is available inside the ATR. Other amenities available upon request.

### Sojka Pavilion, Kinney Natatorium

The satellite athletic training room is located in the back hallway between Sojka Pavilion and Kinney Natatorium. Access is through the back exits of both arenas. The satellite ATR will be open by request or one hour prior to scheduled event. A hydroculator and US/E-Stim is available inside the ATR. Other amenities available upon request.

### Visiting Football Athletic Trainers
