It is great to be writing our first newsletter for 2017 and to tell you that we have had a GREAT start to our season. As many of you may know, we started preseason on Aug 8th and never looked back. We opened our season at home and welcomed Iona, NJIT, St. Peter's and La Salle. It turned out to be a great weekend. We faced La Salle on Friday and came back to win the match 3-2. On Saturday, it just so happens that we decided to play another five-set match

and come back from an 11-14 deficit in the fifth set and beat Iona 17-15. By Sunday, we were a bit more composed and rallied to beat St. Peter's in three sets. It felt great to go 3-0 on our first weekend, but I know we have a very long road ahead before we get into Patriot League play.
